

Macro-imager: Editing Users and Specialities v2


Please note - the C:\Program Files (x86)\Micropix Ltd\Macro-imager folder MUST have write permission in order to edit and save the SessionOptions.xml file.

Navigate to C:\Program Files (x86)\Micropix Ltd\Macro-imager and right-click the SessionOptions.xml file - Select **EDIT WITH XML NOTEPAD**

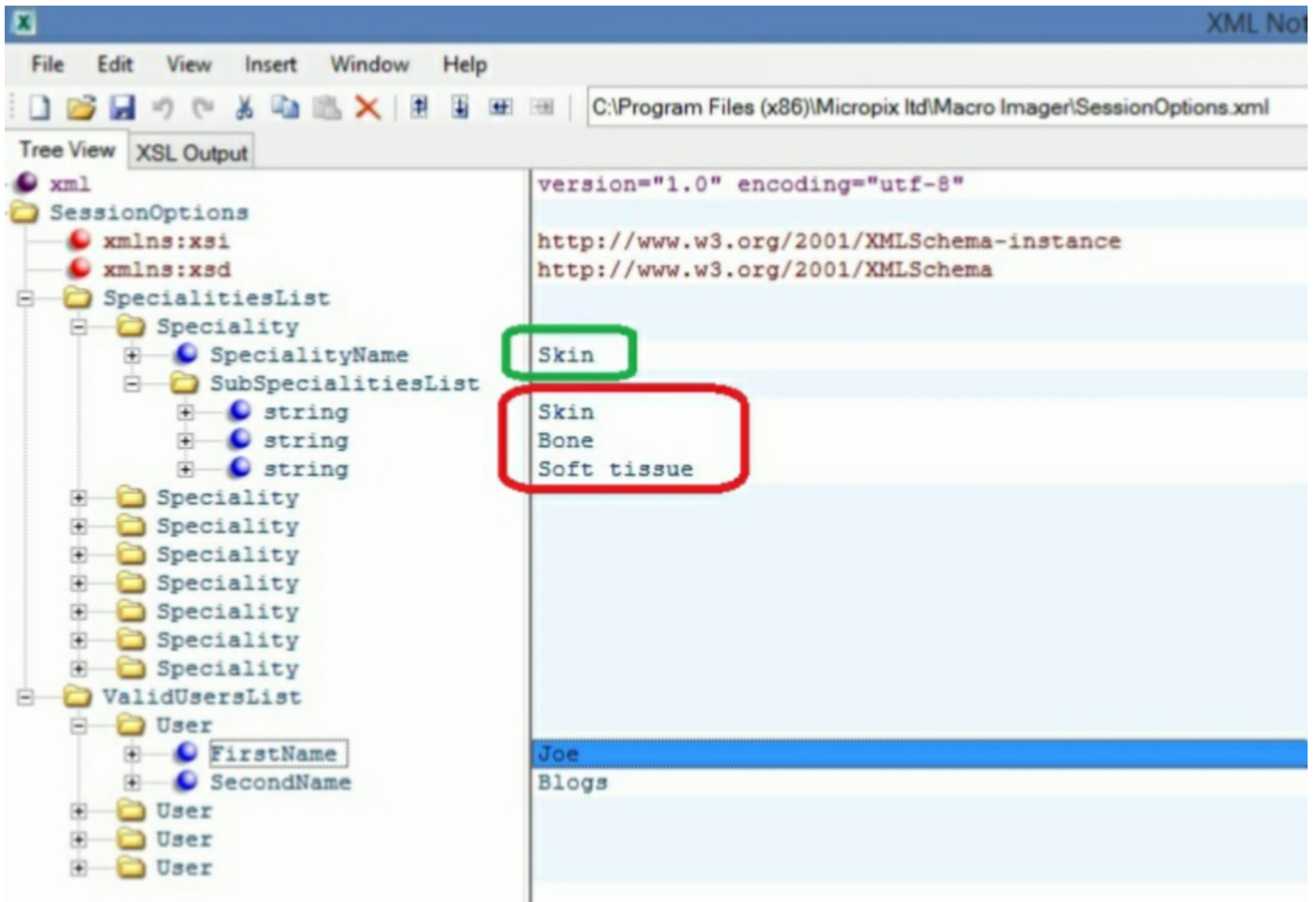

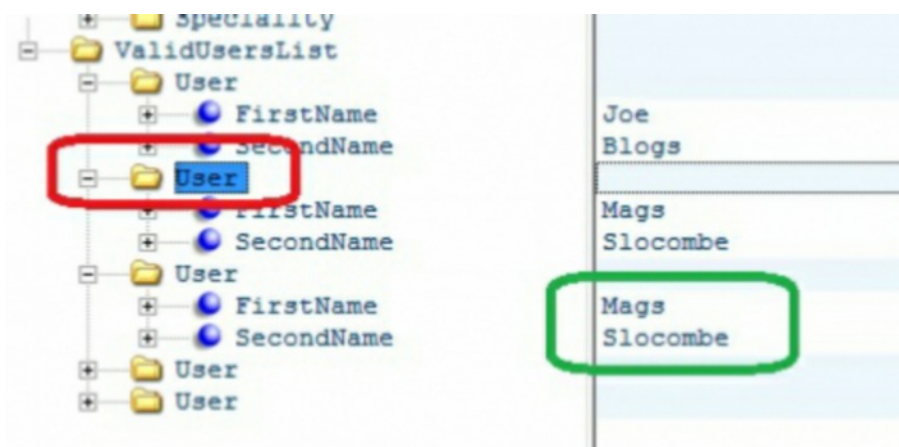

Simply change the text of the “SpecialityName” and the associated Sub-specialities.

Right click on “string” and press “duplicate” to add a Sub-speciality or press “delete” to remove one.

The same principle applies to each folder - right click and “duplicate” to create more or “delete” to remove. E.g. to add more Users, right click on a User folder, click “duplicate” and then edit the first and last name.



When finished, don't forget to save your work! Go to File > Save and over-write the existing SessionOptions.xml file.
